
## Cervical Cancer

Eswatini

had the highest incidence rate of cervical cancer in 2018, followed by

Malawi.

Nearly all cases are caused by two strains of the human papillomavirus (HPV):



both of which account for about 70% of all cervical cancer cases.

but poor access to prevention, screening and treatment contributes to 90% of the deaths.
