

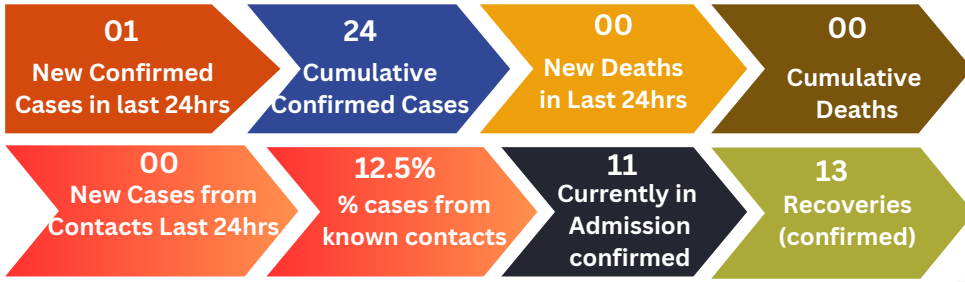

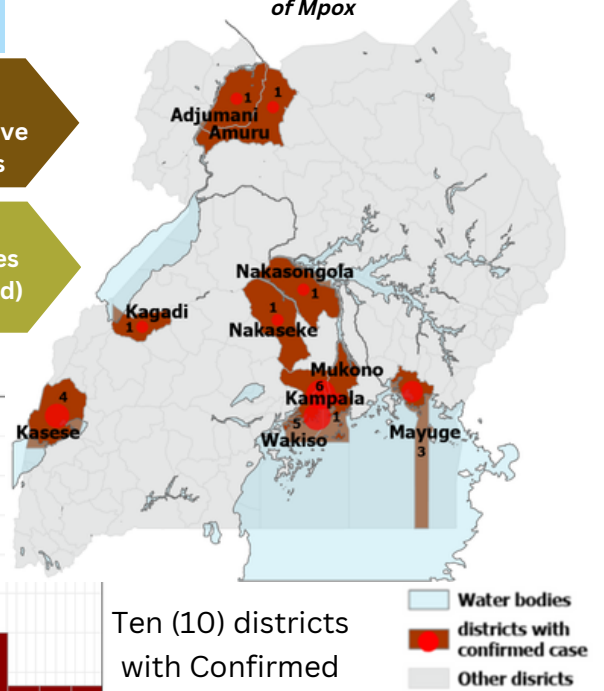

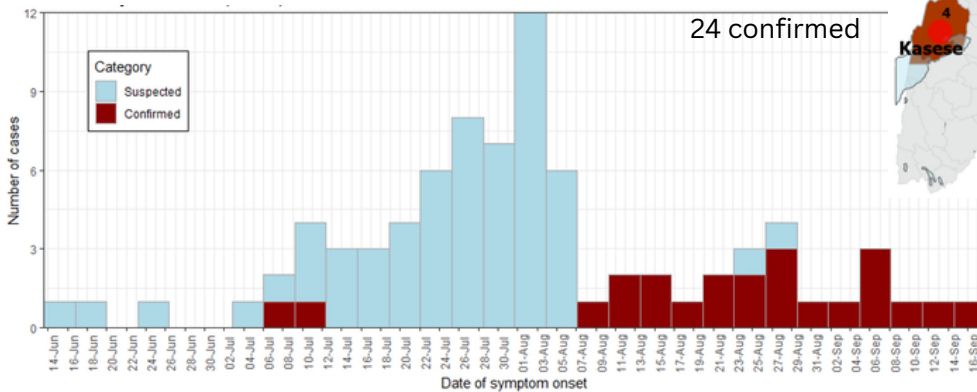
Map of Uganda highlighting districts with confirmed case of Mpox

Other districts

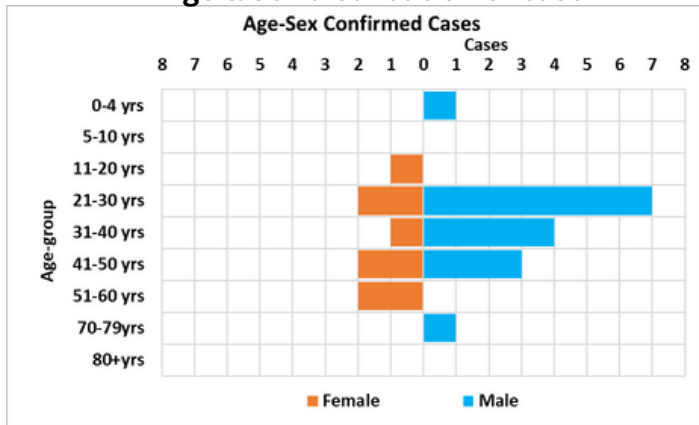

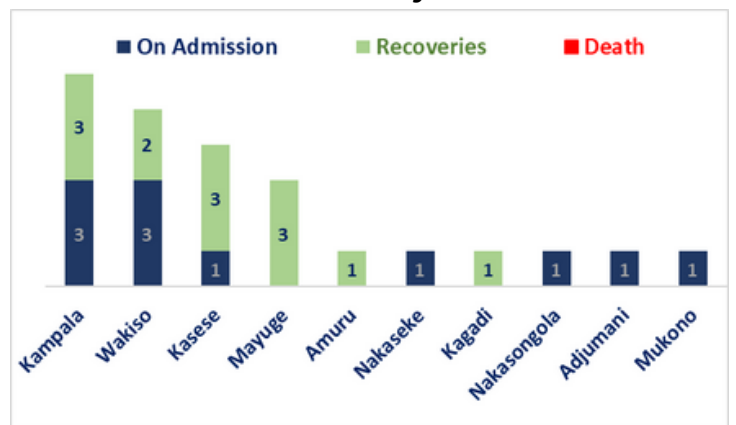
- One new case reported confirmed in the past 24 hours in Kampala.
- The cumulative total confirmed Mpox case since the declaration of the outbreak are 24 (twenty-four).
- No death has been registered among the confirmed cases.
- Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) is at 00/24 (0.0%).
