


Mpox Outbreak in Uganda SITUATION UPDATE - 28 OCTOBER 2024





- Two new confirmed cases reported in the past 24 hours. These were in Kasese and Maracha districts.
- Cumulatively, 222 confirmed cases of Mpox registered, one death, case Fatality Ratio (CFR) is 0.45%.
- A total of 27 cases are yet to be moved to the treatment unit
