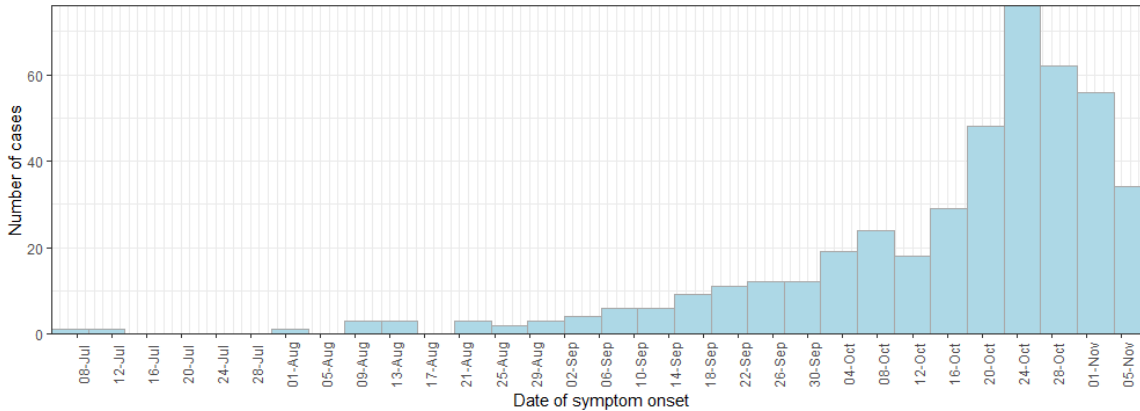

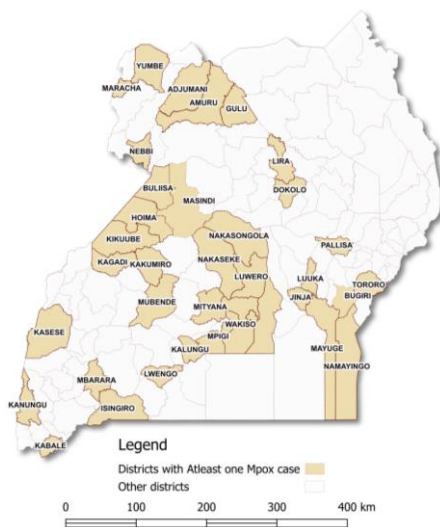
Time analysis of cases (n = 443)



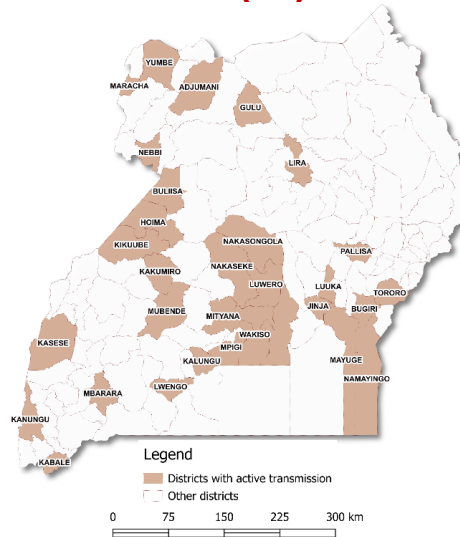
Highlight

- **110** days since the start of the outbreak
- More males **56%** compared to females **44%**
- Most affected age group are working age adults (19-49) years
- Over **61%** of the cases are from the Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area

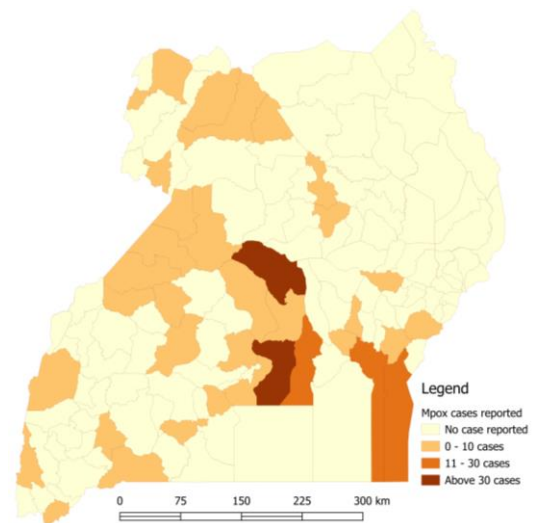

Major activities:

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday)
2. Testing of contacts and suspects
3. Review of the vaccine deployment plan
4. Preparations for super spreader events are under way (Nyege Nyege)
5. Emergency Medical Teams training for regional teams were completed
