





## **Key Highlights**

- 111 days since the start of the outbreak
- Males 56% are more affected
- Working age adults (19-49) years are the most hit 65%
- The Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area accounts for majority of the cases 61%
- Apac and Oyam districts report an Mpox case for the first time
