





Key Highlights


- 118 days since the start of the outbreak
- Districts reporting new cases; Kampala (14), Jinja City (02), Kakumiro (01)
- Majority of the cases are males 56%
- The age group (19-39yrs) are the most affected 58%
- GKMA contributes 62% of the total case load
 - One new death: CFR 0.3%

Major activities



- Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday).
- Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday).
- Pillar specific meetings continue to happen weekly
- Case investigations are being conducted for all positive
- A TOT on assessment tools for Surveillance, Clinical care, and IPC was completed
- A cascade plan for integrated support supervision had been developed by the case management team
- Case management bi-weekly webinars continue to happen
