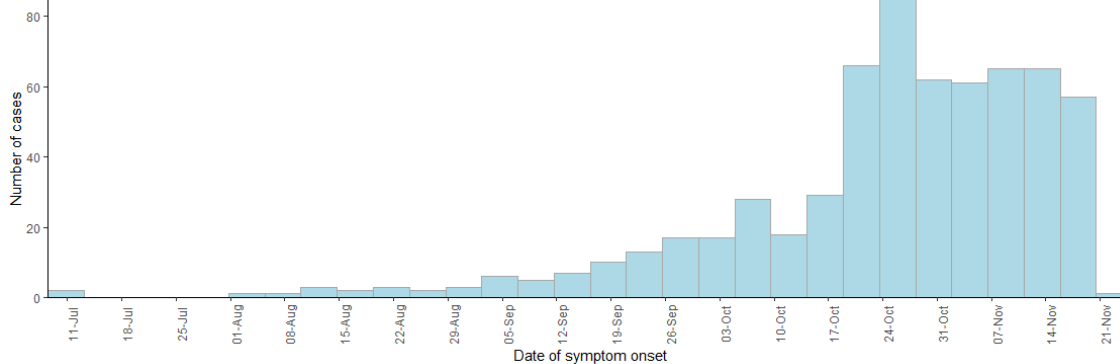

## Key Highlights

- **120** days since the start of the outbreak
- Districts reporting new cases; Wakiso (**04**), Nakasongola (**03**), Mubende (**02**), Mukono (**01**), Amuru (**01**), Mbarara (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **56%**
- Adults (19-39) are the most affected **58%**
- GKMA contributes **63%** of the total case load
- CFR **0.3%**
- Amuru district reports a second case after 93 days without a case

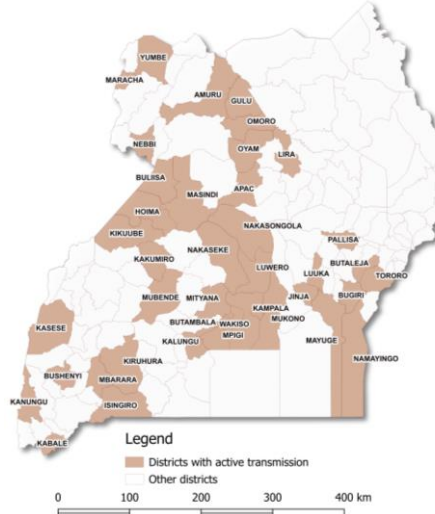
Time analysis of cases (n = 629)



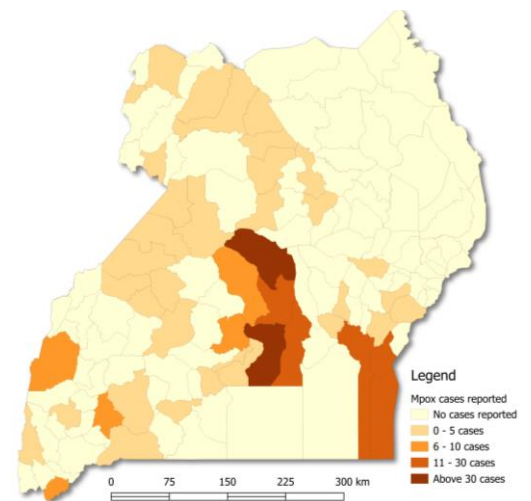
Affected districts (**46**)
