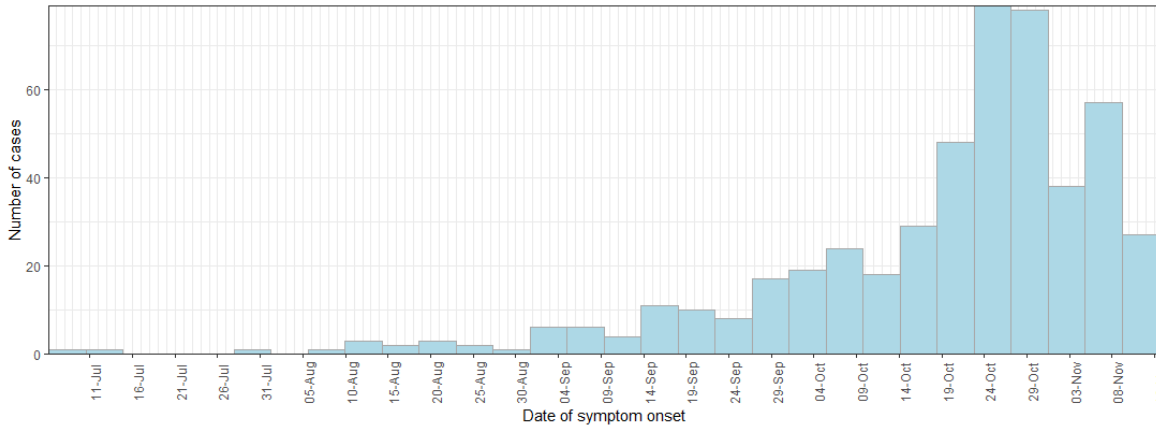

Time analysis of cases (n = 494)



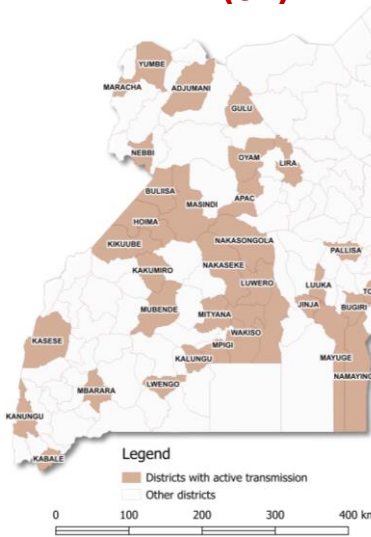
Key Highlights

- **113** days since the start of the outbreak
- Males **58%** are more affected
- Youths (19-29) years are the most hit **38%**
- The Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area accounts for majority of the cases **64%**
- All the new cases (**26**) are from GKMA; Kampala (**21**) and Waksio (**05**)
- Contacts from 5 districts have been retired

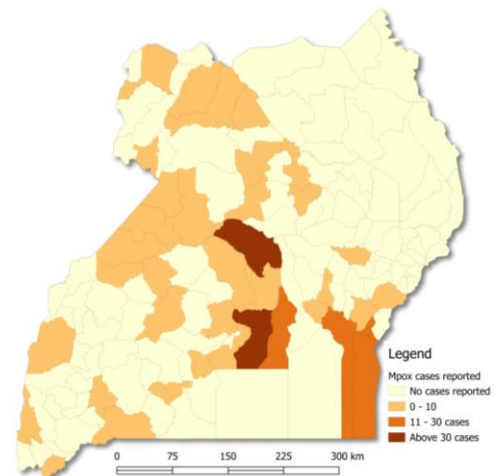
Affected districts **(39)**

Major activities

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday)
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday)
3. The laboratory team has finalised plans for deployment of a mobile laboratory in Arua district to support its testing needs
4. IPC & WASH assessments for isolation units at Entebbe RRH, Bwera GH, Iganga GH were finalised
5. Activation of Rx Solution for National monitoring of stock at all user levels was completed
6. The National Drug Authority had approved MVA-BN vaccine for ages 12 and above. The approval had also been shared with Africa CDC
