




## **Key Highlights**

- 138 days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR 0.7%
- The new case is from Namayingo
- Majority of the cases are males 56%
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected 61%
- GKMA contributes 65% of the total case load
