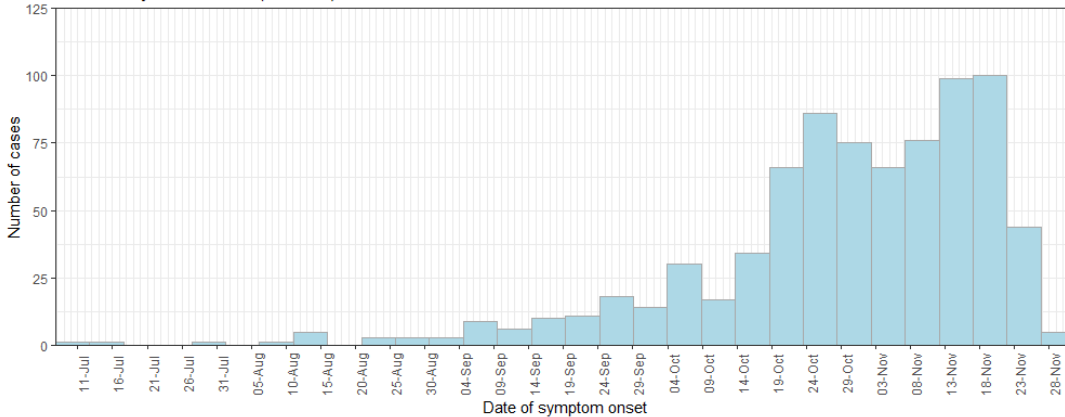

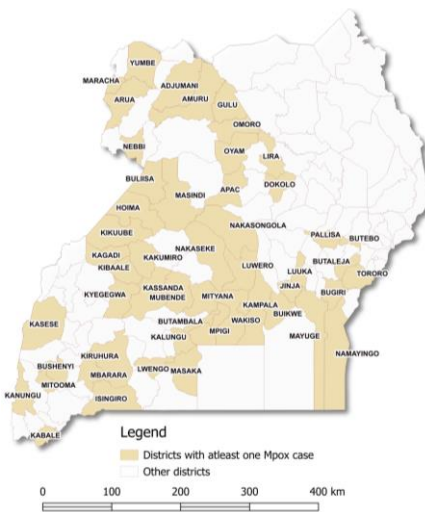
Time analysis of cases (n = 784)



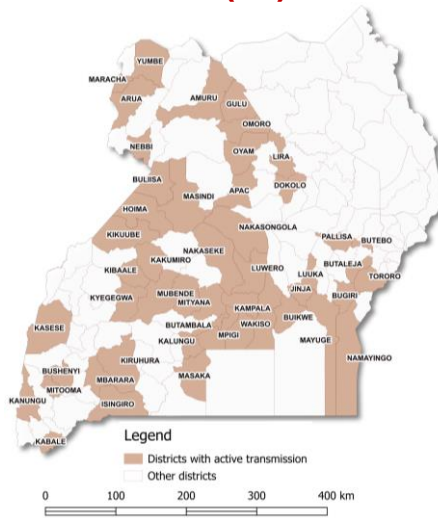
Key Highlights

- **130** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new cases reported in the last 24hrs
- Majority of the cases are males **56%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **60%**
- GKMA contributes **64%** of the total case load
- CFR **0.5%**

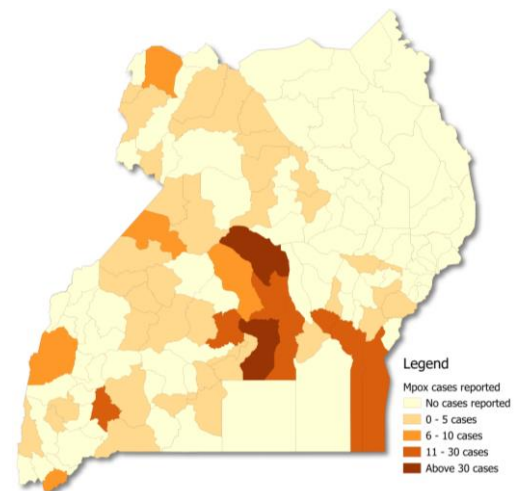
Affected districts (52)

Major activities

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday).
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday).
3. Pillar specific meetings continue to happen weekly
4. Case investigations are being conducted for all positive cases
5. Case management bi-weekly webinars continue to happen
6. Genomic sequencing of positive Mpox samples is ongoing
7. Review and replenishment of stock in response districts is ongoing
