




## **Key Highlights**

- No new deaths, CFR 0.7%
- New cases; Kampala (14), Wakiso (11), Mukono (01), Kakumiro (01)
- Majority of the cases are males 57%
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected 61%
- GKMA contributes 65% of the total case load
