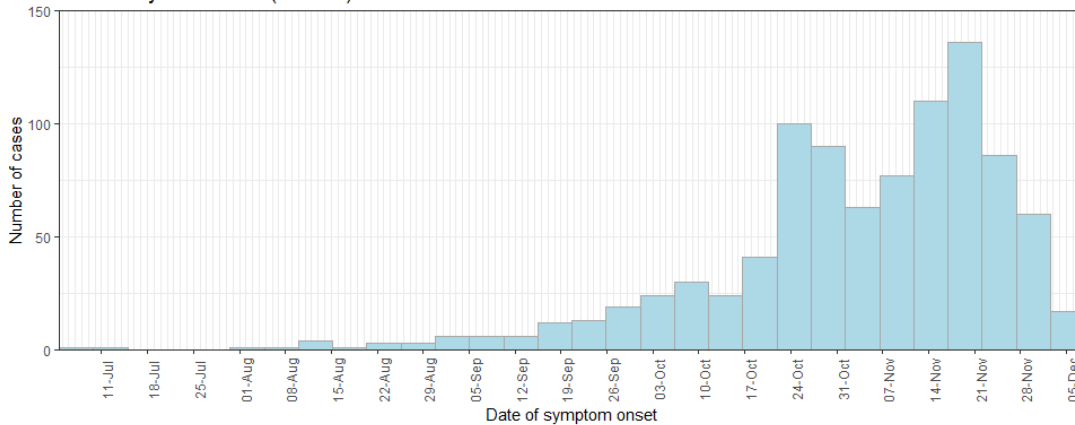

Time analysis of cases (n = 953)



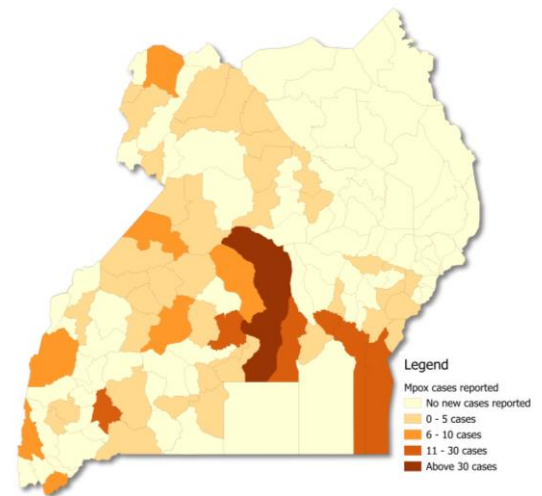
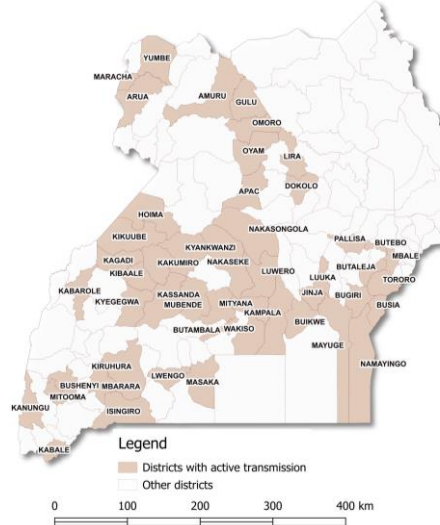
## Key Highlights

- **139** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR **0.7%**
- New cases; Kampala (**14**), Wakiso (**11**), Mukono (**01**), Kakumiro (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **57%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **61%**
- GKMA contributes **65%** of the total case load

6. National TOT for laboratory Mpox sample collection, packaging, transportation was completed
7. Preparations for training materials for the vaccination campaign is underway
