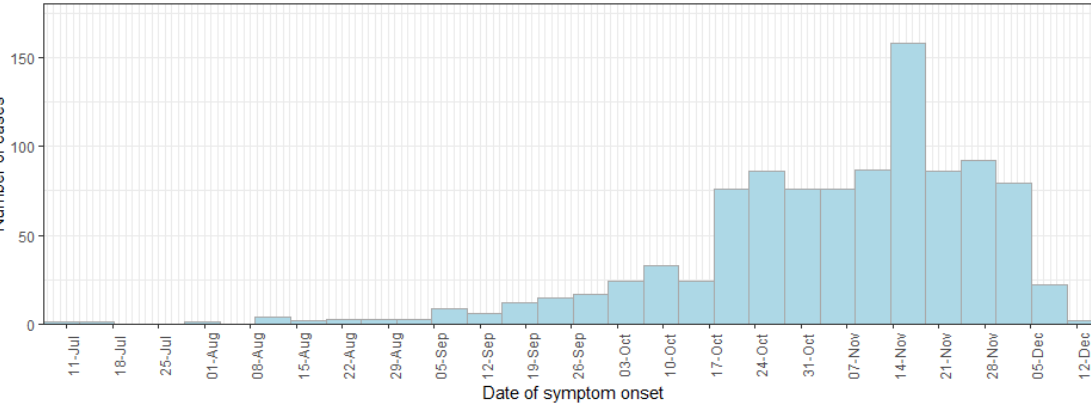

Time analysis of cases (n = 1027)



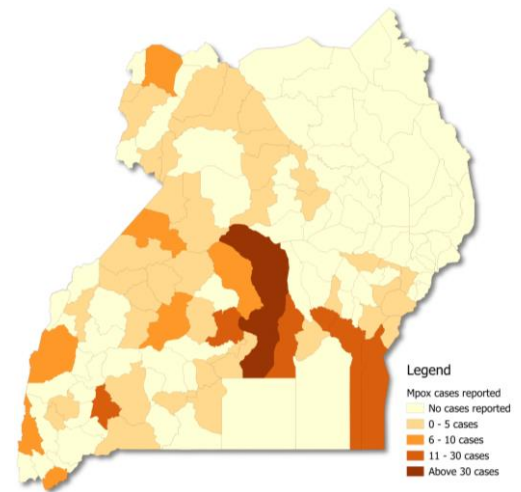
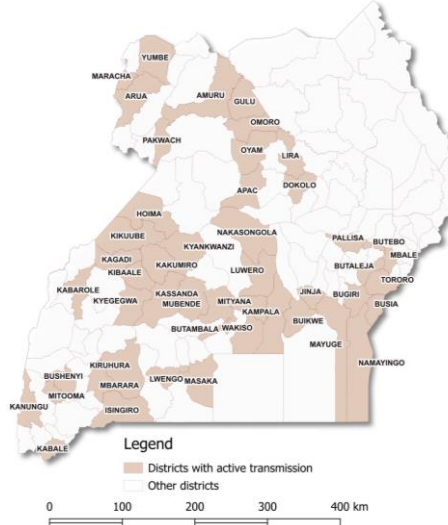
Key Highlights

- **142** days since the start of the outbreak
- No new deaths, CFR **0.6%**
- New cases; Kampala (**15**), Wakiso (**05**), Nakasongola (**03**), Kabale (**02**), Masaka (**01**), Mbarara (**01**), Mukono (**01**)
- Majority of the cases are males **57%**
- The age group (19-39) are the most affected **61%**
- GKMA contributes **67%** of the total case load

6. The RCCE pillar continues to analyse and leverage community feedback insights to generate messages
7. Over 8,010 persons had been reached with audio tower messages
