



# Time Distribution: Daily Incident Mpox Cases by Date of Onset








## Geographical Distribution: Maps Showing Distribution of Mpox Cases.






#### Person Distribution: Charts Showing Person Distribution of Mpox Cases








#### Person Characteristics: Distribution of Underlying Conditions


Proportion of Cases with Underlying Illness Present








## Distribution of Mpox Cases Co-infected with HIV by District
