



Time Distribution: Daily Incident Mpox Cases by Date of Onset








Geographical Distribution: Maps Showing Distribution of Mpox Cases.

Mpox Cases Reported in Last 21 Days








Person Distribution: Distribution of Mpox Deaths by District, Age and Sex




