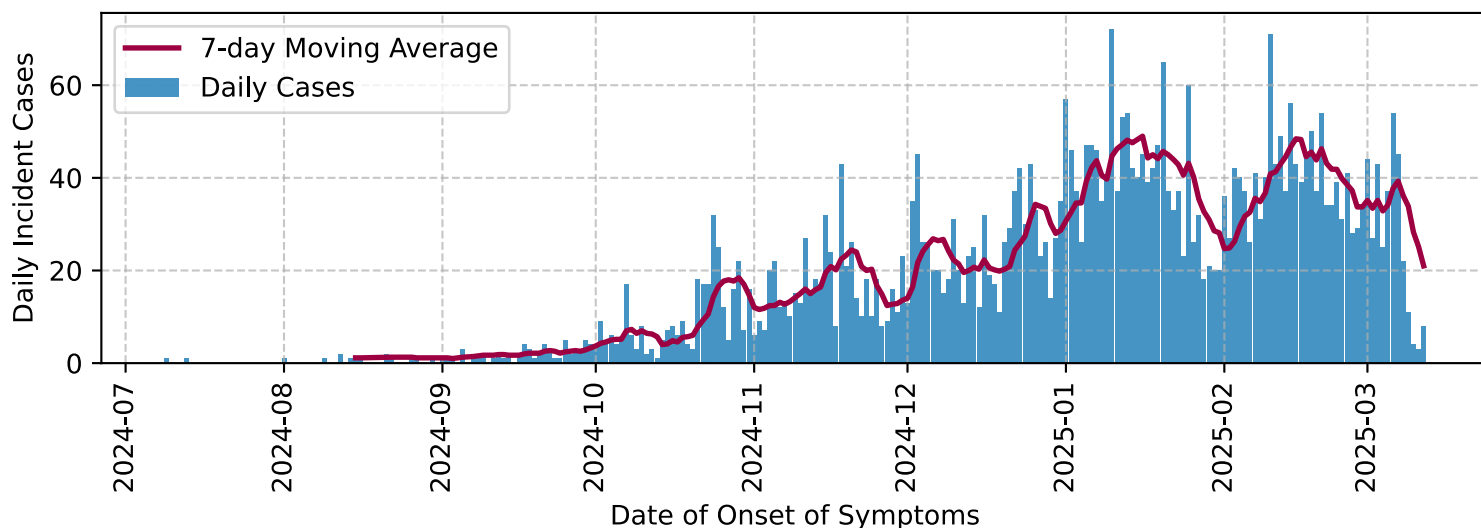

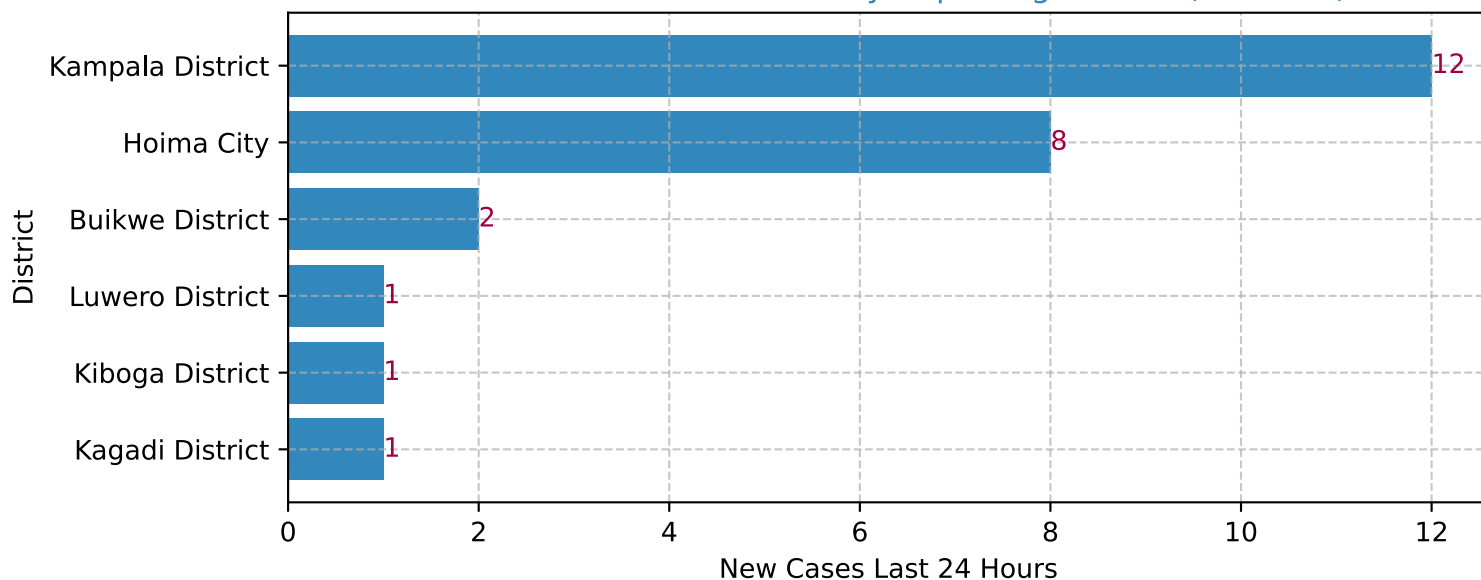

### Time Distribution: Daily Incident Mpox Cases by Date of Onset



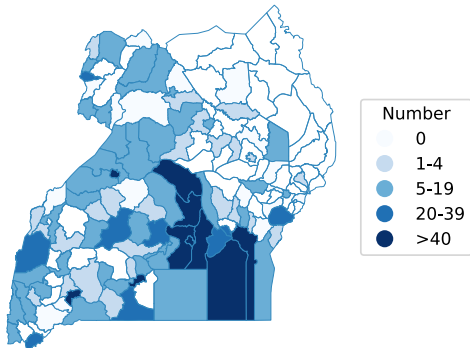

New Cases Last 24 Hours by Reporting District (Total: 25)



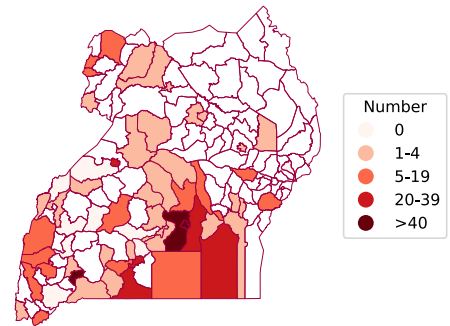
## Geographical Distribution: Maps Showing Distribution of Mpox Cases.

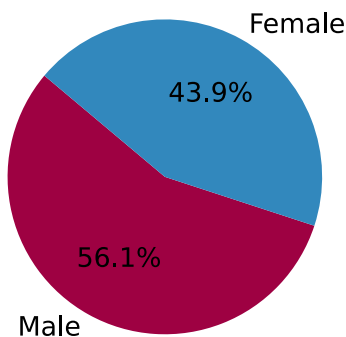

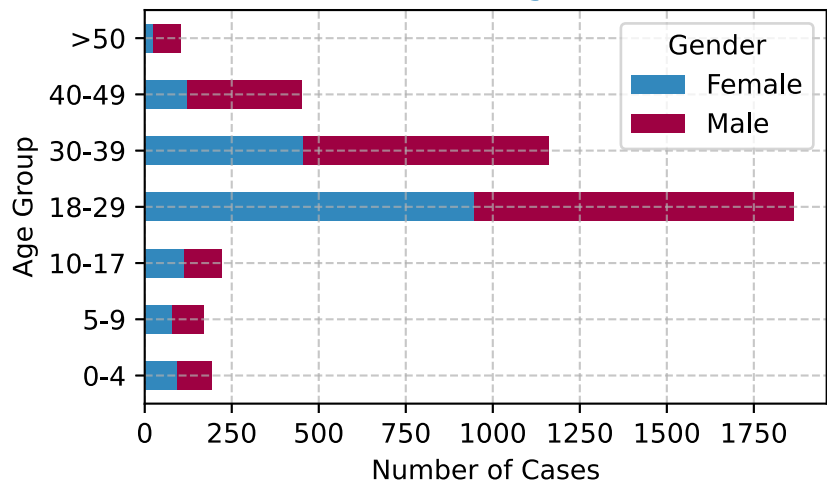

### Gender Distribution

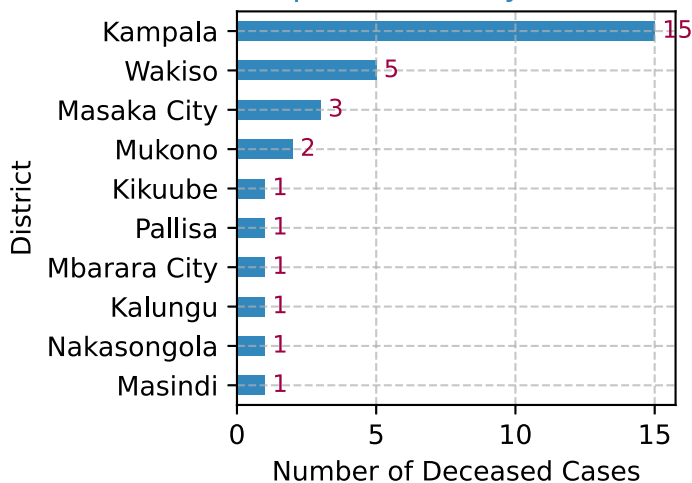


### Distribution of Age and Sex

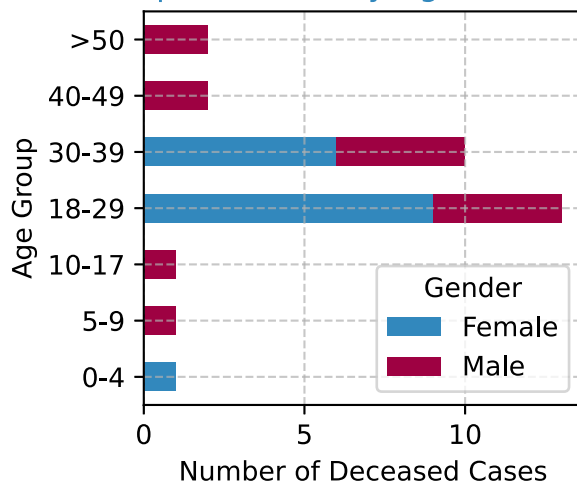
